

1. SCLL procedures for selecting all-star players for 2010
 - A list of players in each age division will be provided to the major division managers.
 - The coaching staff of each major division team will rate the top 15 players in each division—11-12, 11, 9-10. They will rank them in order of 1 through 15, with 1 being the best player in the division.
 - These ratings must be submitted to the SCLL Player Agent by June 11.
 - Votes will be tallied by the SCLL Player Agent and at least one other board member or board designee. If possible, this will be a person without a player on the ballot. The top player receives 15 points; the next player receives 14 points, and so on.
 - The top 10 vote getters in each division make the all-star team.
 - 11 year olds in the top ten in the 11-12 division will play on that team and be replaced on the 11 year old roster by the next top vote getter in that division.
 - All-star managers will receive a list of players with the top 15 vote totals. This would include ties, so there may be more than 15 players listed. Managers will select their final players from this list. SCLL all-star teams must include at least 13 players.
 - A second team may be fielded in the 11 and/or 9-10 year old divisions. Managers for those teams will choose players from the remaining vote getters. They will also be able to include the top minor league players as voted on by the minor league managers.

2. All-star teams should be responsible for providing their own uniforms. (Those divisions for which SCLL already has all-star jerseys may use them.)
